

Justify your material choices. • Which materials disappear in water fastest? Create a results chart and explain why. • Redesign a common object (e.g. toothbrush, chair) using better materials. Draw before & after! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a model or diagram showing layers of the ocean with facts. • Design a bold poster or short video persuading people to protect oceans. • Write a postcard from an ocean animal explaining why oceans matter. • Explain how oceans affect weather using drawings and captions.  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show how a Sikh story from the past helps someone today. • Retell a Sikh story using pictures and short captions. • Report the Easter story as if you're a news reporter. • Write a diary of a Disciple: Write how someone felt during Easter events. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create artwork showing how emotions change through the story. • Write advice to help a character manage feelings. • Create a feelings map, track how colours and emotions change from start to end. • Design tools that help people feel better when emotions fade.

Art and Design Sculpture and 3D: Interactive installation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a small 3D installation using everyday objects and photograph it in place. • Create an artwork inspired by an explosion or movement, using drawing or collage • Design an installation artwork that could transform a space at home or school and explain your idea. 	Music South and West Africa <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create and perform a rhythm inspired by South or West African music. • Make a musical instrument using recycled materials. • Listen to African music and explain how it makes you feel. • Perform your rhythm to someone at home and ask for feedback. 	French Shopping in France <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Design a French market stall and label items with prices in euros. • Act out a short role-play buying items in French. • Plan a shopping list and see if you can buy three items with €10. • Create a café menu using French food and drink vocabulary.
